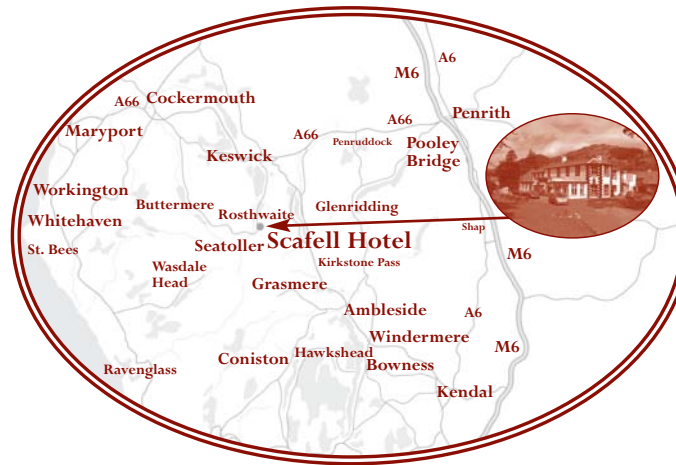

If travelling from the south follow the M6 north to Junction 36 and turn left onto the A590 heading North West. This fast road passes Kendal to the right and leads onto the A591 which leads to Windermere, Ambleside and then onto Keswick.

From the North follow the M6 to junction 40 and turn right onto the A66 heading towards Keswick.

At Keswick, follow the signs for Borrowdale and the B5289. You will travel past Derwentwater on your right and the famous bridge at Grange in Borrowdale. Continue for roughly 2 miles and you come to the village of Rosthwaite where the Scafell Hotel is on your left.

Fell Break Weekends at The Scafell Hotel

It was in the early 80's that The Scafell became one of the first, if not the first hotel, to run regular guided walk weekends. Since then many people have partaken in them and subsequently returned year after year to hear more about our valleys, mountains, hamlets and general history of the area.

These walks last about six hours (subject to a minimum of six guests), are accompanied by the hotel owner and/or experienced guides and are around 10/12 miles long giving a leisurely pace and unless weather conditions on the fell tops are unfavourable, they are high level, up to and over 2000ft. After breakfast on the Sunday there is a shorter walk of some 2 hours, usually low level in the valley before returning for Sunday Lunch.

Wind and waterproof, warm clothing is required together with strong walking boots. Trainers and wellington boots are not considered suitable. In order to make the most of a Fell Break Weekend quite a number of guests are now taking advantage of the very special Midweek Break terms and extending their stays on Thursday and Sunday nights, giving them an extra two nights relaxation.

A Fell Break Weekend programme is for those who wish to partake - nothing is compulsory. Guests taking a Fell Break can do all or none of the programme and if you decide to walk or go off independently the choice remains with you.
